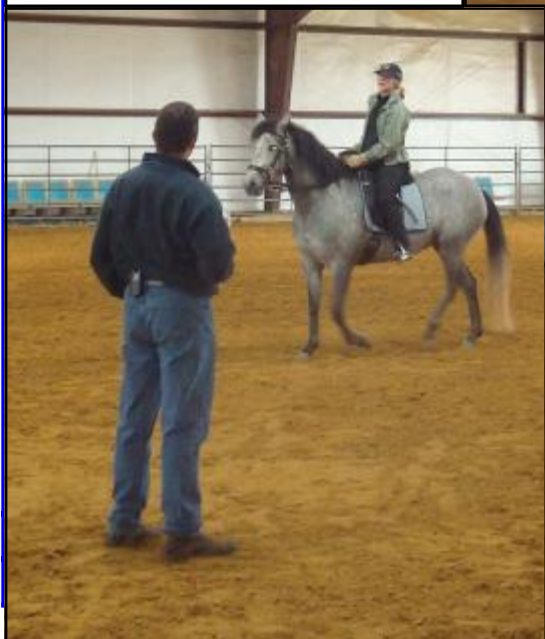

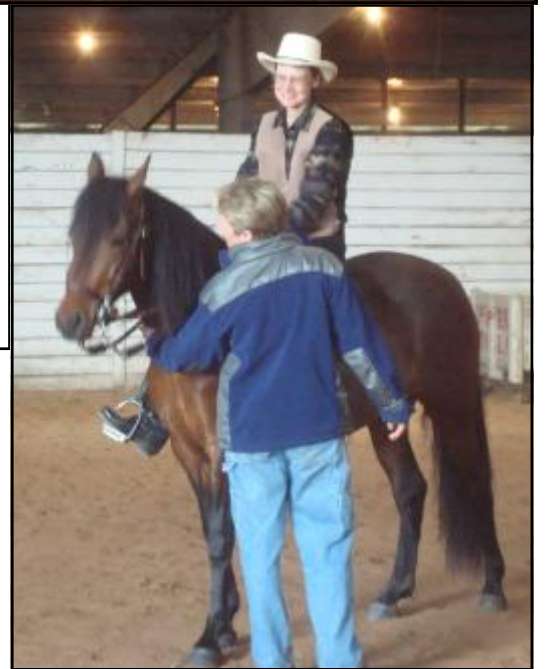

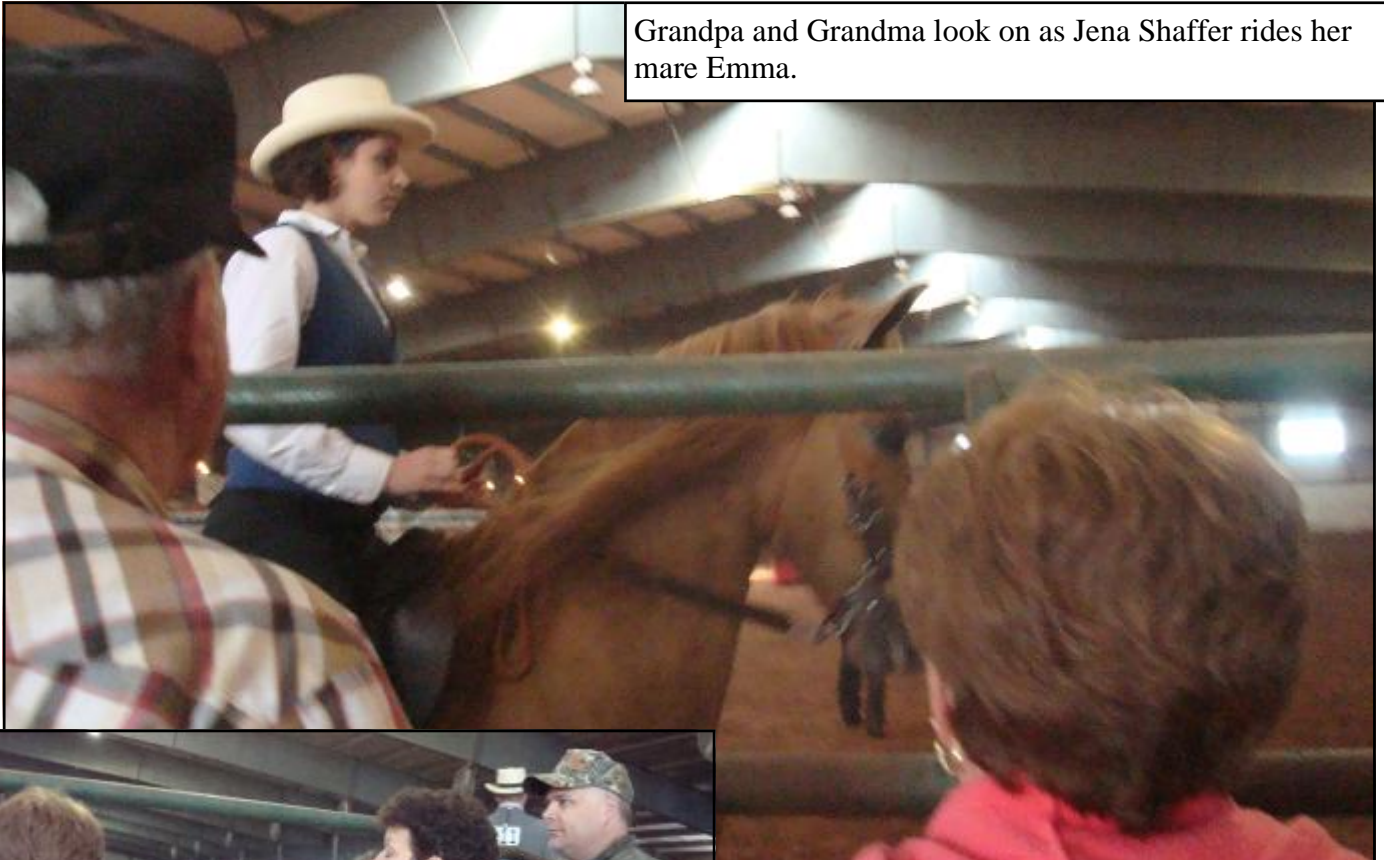

## REGIONAL NEWS – SIDE SADDLE ANYONE?



Oscar and I rode SIDESADDLE for two historical events in NJ on May 3 and 4. Oscar is a rescue and has put on enough weight that I changed his sidesaddle to a wider tree style called a Legend. Instead of a heavy Western Sidesaddle, the Legend is a stripped down version that was the basis for all the western "bar tree" Sidesaddles since approximately 1868. My friend, and sidesaddle "expert", Shelly, says the Legend fits Oscar better than the narrower Western saddle I used previously.

Unfortunately, we did not have our own photographer for the Spirit of the Jerseys on Saturday, but my husband, John Samtak, took photos of us at Fosterfields Living History Farm near Morristown NJ on Sunday. The Farm's history traces from the Revolutionary War through 2008. They "hey day" of the Farm was 1860-1926, when it was owned by the Foster Family.

Our riding habits span the time period from my reproduction Civil War Period Habit to Carla's 1906, Shelly's 1924, and Tracy's 1940s Original Antique Habits.

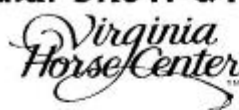

A NON-MEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A \$20 NON-MEMBER REGISTRATION FEE AND A \$5 BREED/DISCIPLINE CATEGORY FEE FOR EACH BREED/DISCIPLINE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE; 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK, TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES; 7) NRHA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS; 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES; 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION; 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION; AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.

## **USEF RULES REGARDING GOLF CARTS**

VIOLATIONS OF THIS RULE WILL BE CAUSE FOR SANCTIONS AGAINST THE PARENT(S), GUARDIAN(S), AND/OR TRAINER(S) WHO ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CHILD COMMITTING THE OFFENSE. PENALTIES MAY INCLUDE EXCLUSION OF THE CHILD, PARENT(S), GUARDIAN(S), AND/OR TRAINER(S) FROM THE COMPETITION GROUNDS FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE COMPETITION AND CHARGES BEING FILED AGAINST ANY OF THE ABOVE INDIVIDUALS IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 6. WHEELCHAIRS AND OTHER MOBILITY ASSISTANCE DEVICES FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES ARE EXEMPT FROM THIS RULE.

## **OPPORTUNITY CLASS RULES**

1. Rider cannot have shown previously in any pointed PFHA class.
2. Rider does not have to be a member of PFHA or USEF to show in the Opportunity Classes.
3. The horse must be a PFHA registered Paso Fino and the Rider does not have to own the horse.
4. Classes will be judged in accordance with the official PFHA Rule Book for each division with the exception of the riding attire as stated in Number 5.
5. Riders are not required to ride in the official PFHA Costume for the division in which they are showing. They are required to wear appropriate casual riding attire. This includes slacks or dark jeans (no shorts), chaps, a casual shirt with sleeves such as a polo shirt or dress shirt. Proper riding boots are required. For participants twelve years of age and under, a riding helmet will be required.
6. If the Horse is only being ridden in the Opportunity Classes then the USEF Drugs/Medications Fee of \$12.00 does not apply to this horse.
7. The Opportunity Class Fee will be a flat fee of \$10 per class.
