






1. Some how Dick Teachout found dry land on his farm to park the trailers. Thankfully we didn't need to use any of his boats that are in the background.

Carlos is the 2007 Paso Fino Horse Association Trainer of the Year. Carlos was born in Columbia, SA, and is a third generation Paso Fino breeder. Carlos graduated from Lenoir Rhyne College in Hickory, NC, with a degree in International Business. Carlos has a unique gift to "read" the horse as well as its rider. He teaches the rider to ride his horse from a training perspective. His clinics, held throughout the US, Canada and Europe since 1997, are always well attended with clients marveling at the changes in their horses after a few short sessions. To compliment Carlos's clinics, he has written a book and produced several DVDs on riding a Paso Fino and what to look for in a show horse for the different divisions. Carlos also provides pre-purchase and breeding consultations.

Carlos will work one on one with individual instruction for each horse and rider team. Auditors are always welcomed at his clinics if you are unable to bring a horse and would just like to listen and see how he works with the many different horse and rider teams.

We have new classes added to our May Day Show. Please look over the show bill and notice the Opportunity Classes that have been added. The following are the rules for these new classes.

OPPORTUNITY CLASS RULES

- 1. Rider cannot have shown previously in any pointed PFHA class.
- 2.Rider does not have to be a member of PFHA or USEF to show in the Opportunity Classes.
- 3. The horse must be a registered Paso Fino with PFHA and the Rider does not have to own the horse.
- 4.Classes will be judged in accordance with the official PFHA Rule Book for each division with the exception of the riding attire as stated in Number 5.
- 5.Riders are not required to ride in the official PFHA Costume for the division in which they are showing. They are required to wear appropriate casual riding attire, such as slacks or dark jeans (no shorts), chaps, and a casual shirt is permitted with sleeves such as a polo shirt or dress shirt and proper riding boots are required. For participants twelve years of age and under, a riding helmet will be required.
- 6.If the Horse is only being ridden in the Opportunity Classes then the USEF Drug Fee does not apply to this horse.
- 7. The Opportunity Class Fee will be a flat fee of \$10 per class.
