Drive 3.4 mi to the Mason Dixon Campground. Turn right, at the "Y" and go 3.1 miles to the stop sign. Turn Right onto Rt. 160 go 1 mile to Paso Fino Rd.

Feasting and Tall Tales will commence after the ride. Bring a Covered Dish to share. The Flatware and drink will be provided. Lynn is making a big pot of vegetable soup. Yum!

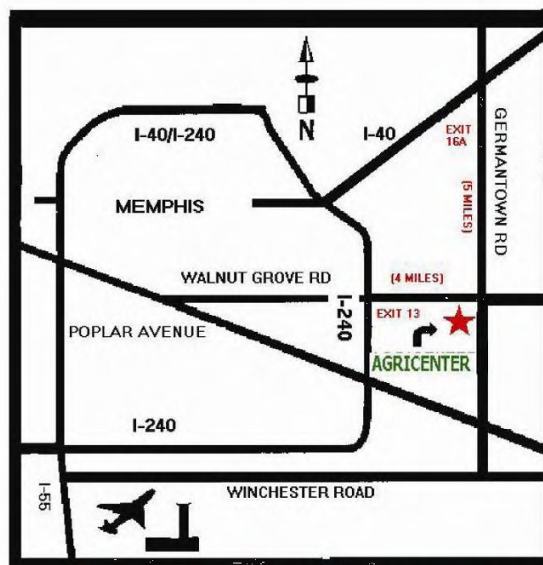
### **From the West:**

Travel I-40 east across the bridge into downtown Memphis, follow I-40 to I-240 east. Take Walnut Grove (exit 13) heading east. Go east on Walnut Grove approx 2 ½ miles. Turn right into the Agricenter entrance... Agricenter Expo Center is the large grayish white building on the right past the Ducks Unlimited entrance, Show Place Arena is the large yellowish building on your left past the Farmer's Market (Red Barn).

### **From the South:**

Travel I-55 north towards Memphis. Follow signs to I-240 east (exit 6A). Follow I-240 east until you reach Walnut Grove (exit 13) heading east. Go east on Walnut Grove approximately 2 ½ miles. Turn right into the Agricenter en-

trance... Agricenter Expo Center is the large grayish white building on the right past the Ducks Unlimited entrance, Show Place Arena is the large yellowish building on your left past the Farmer's Market (Red Barn).

## By the Time I get to Cave Creek.....

It seems like it was just yesterday, the 2006 Grand National in Perry Georgia, showing my paso gelding Enrique DWH! We lived in Shepherdstown, WV and had a few good trails to ride on in my neighborhood. Now, the Summer of 2011, we are in Cave Creek Arizona, riding a gazillion miles of trails right out my back gate! This winter on a trip to California, my dad and I visited Cave Creek, and that was that!

We have a mini-ranch in the Desireable Desert Hills Horse Community! Two blocks from the ANTHEM Trail Head, which links the Maricopa Country 1500 mile trail system to the State Recreational Area at Cave Creek, to the Spur Cross Ranch recreational area to the U.S. Park Service entrance to the TONTO NATIONAL FOREST, my little horse facility is a semi-retiree dream come true. In the other direction there is the City of Phoenix Park and Preserve: A FIVE MILE SQUARE of mountains and Sonoran desert.



Paints are everywhere including a Paso Fino Ranch in North Scottsdale. The Show and Event season starts around October, so I will be updating Mason Dixon members with our adventures when that time comes.

For now, we have joined the Lone Rangers Singles Riding Club of Cave Creek. They sound like a fun bunch that likes to camp out and ride the trails once a month! RIGHT UP OUR ALLEY. Again most stuff starts in September or October, but in Flagstaff there are huge horse events happening right now.

They are at 8000 feet elevation, so the summer temps are much cooler. Enrique and I live at 2000 feet, With the Sonoran Desert at our doorstep. Once we are old hat at all this new, we may spend some of next Summer up in the higher elevations, but for now, trail riding has always been our passion and that is what we are content to do.

We miss all the fun people in Mason Dixon, but we are very happy riding the trails here North of Phoenix, Arizona in Cave Creek.

## Trail Riding Parks and Areas We Love

This is the first of occasional series of articles on places our members like to trail ride. If you would like to share your favorite place with our members, please contact me and I'll send you a template.—Diane Dutt

### Codorus State Park, Southern York County, Pennsylvania

**General Description:** The 3,452-acre Codorus State Park is in the rolling hills of southern York County. The 1,275-acre Lake Marburg has 26 miles of shoreline and is a rest stop for migrating waterfowl and shorebirds. The lake is also popular with sail boaters and motor boaters. Anglers love the lake for warm water fishing and can also fish Codorus Creek for trout. Picnicking, swimming in the pool and camping are popular activities.

**Horse Trails: 8 miles:** Ranger Trail travels over rolling hills, through forests and fields, crosses streams and passes near Lake Marburg. There are many views of the lake, including Ranger Overlook which has benches and hitching posts. The 40-trailer parking lot is off of the Main Launch Day Use Area entrance road.

**Personal observations:** Our typical ride here is about 4 hours long, though, of course we could easily spend the day. The trails vary in elevation and we've found them to range from easy to slightly more challenging. There are several locations along the lake shore where you can swim your horse. Most of the trails are through hardwood forests, though sometimes you ride along fields of corn. Road crossings are rare and traffic is usually light.

### #3 of PFHA Top 10 Pasos for Pleasure—2010

**Barbara Adrian — 470.5 hrs.**

Horses have always been a passion of mine. In my late teens, my parents allowed me to have my very own horse. I grew older and priorities changed. Marriage and the birth of my children made horse ownership impractical. It was when my daughters were young and began riding that horses once again became part of my daily life. We started with ponies and hunter-type horses. Once my children were grown and had lives of their own, I began to endurance ride and owned a series of Arabian horses. Time passed and around 6 years ago, in my late 60s, I began looking for a trail horse that I could enjoy but still had that fiery spirit.

A few years before I had tried a Paso Fino horse at High Gait Farm. I returned there and bought my first Paso, Montanero HG, a gelding out of Capuchino. Over the past 6 years, Monty has taught me a lot about the rewards of patience and consistency. He has also given me a true appreciation for the entire Paso breed. I have since acquired a second Paso Fino. He has a different personality than Monty, but he is no less a favorite on the farm.

Pasos love to go and are fun to ride. They seem less fearful than some other breeds I've owned, and that makes them even more desirable as a trail horse. Their surefootedness is another trait that makes them the perfect breed to ride in the mountains of West Virginia. Now in my 70s, I still look forward every day to the time I spend with my Paso Finos. Thanks to the smooth gaits and dependability of my horses. I hope to still be enjoying their unique personalities well into my 80s.
