

### REGIONAL NEWS—MINUTES FROM THE MASON DIXON ANNUAL MEETING AND AWARDS BANQUET

On Saturday, November 1, 2008, the Mason Dixon Paso Fino Horse Association held its Annual Meeting and Awards Banquet at Fieldstone Meadows, Dallastown, PA. The potluck dinner was a tremendous hit with dishes including barbequed Buffalo hot dogs and hamburgers, chili, several different kinds of salads and other side dishes, as well as appetizers and desserts. Another change to the venue this year included a Youth fun night the evening of the banquet followed by a Youth clinic and trail ride on Sunday. The 47 members, to include several new members, who attended the event, enjoyed a day of camaraderie, engaging conversations and a wonderful feast.

President Lisa Gorsuch welcomed everyone to the event and called the meeting to order. Following introductions by the attendees, the meeting began with the approval of the minutes for last year's meeting and the reading of the association's financial status. Here are some of the highlights from the activity reports presented during the meeting.

As the National Delegate, B.J. Schuler provided a recap of the PFHA Board meeting held in Atlanta, GA the week previous. A major push is on to encourage regional members to join the national level organization. Over the past few years, PFHA has experienced an overall decline in membership. Only three regions, including Mason Dixon, have increased membership. The Amateur Owner Committee is preparing a book for new members on "What you need to know about showing", although the availability of the book is unknown at this time. You may begin to notice changes in the PFHA web site as well as Paso Fino Horse World. The website is being revised to be more user friendly, while the magazine is now being published by PFHA and will consist of 8 issues a year. The National Show in Perry, GA was profitable this year. Perry GA will continue to be the venue for at least another two years, but PFHA is continuing to look for other options. New officers will be voted on in January 2009. Their biographies are on the PFHA website. Two other main issues discussed included the possibility of losing a seat in the Confepaso to the American Trote and Trocha Association (ATTA) and the availability of funds from the Paso Fino Horse Foundation to support youth activities.

Regionally, MDPFHA is preparing for the two Horse World Expositions in Maryland and Pennsylvania. Maryland's event will once again be held at the fairground in Timonium and will run from January 15<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup>. Lisa Gorsuch is the point of contact for anyone interested in helping to support the booth. Pennsylvania's event is being held at the Farm Show Complex in Harrisburg from Feb 26<sup>th</sup> to Mar 1<sup>st</sup>. Sheri Becker is the point of contact for anyone interested in helping to support the booth.

The shows for this year will include the May Day Show in Dillsburg, PA, May 2 – 3 with Lisa Gorsuch as the organizer; Mason Dixon Spectacular Show in Lexington, VA, June 12 – 14 with BJ Schuler as the organizer; and, the Keystone International Livestock Exposition (KILE) at the Farm Show Complex in Harrisburg, PA, date to be determined with Jim Laird as the organizer. Specific discussion on the shows included inviting the Icelandic Horses to the May Day Show; getting the following volunteers to assist with the MD Spectacular, Sponsorship – Diane Dutt, Silent Auction – Ann Bastian, Games – Nola Haupert-Keill, Decorations – Nick Burgos, Support for Officials – Maryan Schlesman, and Trail Class design and set-up – Diane Dutt; Trail Ride on Jun 11 to start late afternoon; and, securing commitments for sponsorships for KILE (Rick Shaffer, Nola Haupert-Keill, Nick Burgos, Lisa Gorsuch, Jim Laird, Diane Dutt and Karen Basehore). Lisa Gorsuch also stressed the importance of the Futurity program. Members engaged in a great discussion on different options to increase the program. Goal is to get members to nominate stallions!

Other activity reports included parades, clinics and fundraisers. Diane Dutt provided a list of parades for the next two months, which included Lansdale Holiday parade Nov 22<sup>nd</sup>, Souderton parade Dec 6<sup>th</sup>, Red Hill parade Dec 7<sup>th</sup>; and Charles Town WV parade Dec 14<sup>th</sup>. The desired attire for the parades is red jacket, black pants, straw hats and white saddle pads with appliqués. A number of clinics were conducted over the past year, all of which paid for themselves. Part of the discussion in regards to clinics included recommendations on how to reach out to Paso Fino owners who are not current members of MDPFHA, but would benefit from a clinic on fundamentals. One other particular note of interest was the approval to replace the existing sounding board. Recommendations for raising the money to do this included having a Regional Paso Fino Open House in spring.

Other short notes include the addition of Amateur/Owner high points award; the gelding raffle (Nola Haupert-Keill has tickets); brief description of the Trail Blazer program; Sheri Becker continues to be the POC for PFHW regional news; Nola Haupert-Keill is the Youth Coordinator; Virginia Foster is the coordinator for the power glide and website; and, Karen Basehore is the POC for MDPFHA Membership.

Just prior to adjourning for dinner and the awards ceremony, the members elected the following MDPFHA Officers: President – Lisa Gorsuch; National Delegate – Virginia Foster; Vice President – Diane Dutt; Secretary – Karen Basehore; and, Treasurer – Beth Webb.




### <u>View from the Rear</u> by Carolyn Marinko



Re: Preliminary Report

Due to the importance of the issues discussed at the CONFEPASO meeting held in Ponce, Puerto Rico on December 4, 2008, and at the request of PFHA President, I am forwarding PFHA Board of Directors members this preliminary report.

- Mr. C.J. Marcello's resignation as President of CONFEPASO was unanimously accepted. Mr. Victor Chavarro, former Vice-President, assumed the presidency.
- The minutes from the July 2008 Medellin meeting was approved.
- The charges submitted by the International Judges were reviewed with the following results; Mr. Evencio Gómez from Venezuela was sanctioned for four years, Mr. Eduardo Conte from Venezuela, Mr. Eduardo Rojo, Mr. Victor Vélez and Ms. Dora Luz Hernández from Colombia were each sanctioned for two years. These sanctions are to be honored by all countries affiliated to CONFEPASO.
- After an investigation on the case of the young rider Javier Arias, CONFEPASO unanimously voted to return the gold medal to him and to issue a public apology. The medal was presented along with the apology to Mr. Arias on Sunday December 7<sup>th</sup> at the Pachín Vicéns Coliseum during the Ponce International Show.
- PFHA's President, Robin Ratliff acting as Delegate and Mr. Ed Smith as guest of CONFEPASO addressed the members and were very well received. I presented a summary of the upcoming report to the PFHA Board on the diagonals, which was also well received.
- The issue of ATTA was discussed and was agreed unanimously that it will not be brought again to CON-FEPASO since the By Laws are clear in that the member of CONFEPASO are the countries, not the entities, associations or federations. It was also reiterated that PFHA is entitled to both seats in CONFEPASO.
