Pre-Entries must be received by July 4, 2025. Entries received after July 4 will pay the postentry fee. Entries should be emailed; scan and send to kenie@bellsouth.net

Documents that should be emailed are -

PFHA Entry Form – completed and signed, Registration papers, PFHA card (Amateur if applicable), Negative Coggins less than 12 months old, Health Certificate less than 30 days old if from out of New Jersey.

At time of check in at the show office, you must leave a signed check (made payable to Mason Dixon PFHA) or pay by credit card. ENTRY NUMBERS WILL NOT BE ISSUED BY THE SHOW OFFICE WITHOUT EITHER A SIGNED CHECK OR A CREDIT CARD ON FILE. Credit card payments are subject to a 4% service fee.

STALLS: To reserve stalls, send a text that includes all horses and owners that are to be stabled together, as well as any additional shavings you wish to pre-order, to Nicholas Burgos at 484-256-4625. One bag of shavings is included with each horse stall. Please only list the EXTRA SHAVINGS that you wish to order. Shavings that come with your stall and any shavings you order before the show will be at your stall upon arrival. (No outside bedding is allowed to be brought into the Dream Park.) Stalls at regular rate will be available at noon on Thursday July 10, 2025, and must be vacated by noon on Monday, July 14, 2025. Stalls are available on Wednesday July 9, for early arrival for an additional fee and by prior arrangement with the Barn Manager. Horses may be stabled only in the stalls designated for their owner by show management. Use of other stalls not designated to you may result in additional fees.

Early arrivals: \$20 additional per stall, with advance arrangement with the Barn Manager.

Extra Shavings: \$10 per bag (text 484-256-4625 to order before the show, or order in show office during show)

RV Spaces – The Dream Park has 78 camping spots with electric and water hookups. Camping is \$40 per night. Reservations can be made with the Barn Manager when you reserve your stalls. Payment can be made to the Show Secretary at the show.

### IMPORTANT SHOW INFORMATION FOR ALL EXHIBITORS

**Lodging:** Host Hotel - Hampton Inn Swedesboro, 2 Pureland Dr, Swedesboro, NJ 856-467-6200. Mention Paso Fino Horse Show to get the group rate. Cutoff date for the group rate is 6/19/25.

**Directions**: Dream Park, 400 US Route 130, Logan Twp, NJ.

From Pennsylvania: Take Route 322 East over the Commodore Barry Bridge crossing into New Jersey to Route 130 South. The Dream Park is 1.6 miles on the right.

From Delaware and South: Take 295 North over the Delaware Memorial Bridge. Take Exit 10, Center Square Rd. Turn left and go 1.5 miles. Turn right onto Route 130 North. The Dream Park is 1 mile on the left.

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**SCHEDULE CHANGES/CANCELLATIONS**: Management reserves the right to add, split, combine, cancel, or run concurrently any class or classes as needed for the show, or to reschedule classes after notification to exhibitors. Management also reserves the right to change or alter the officials listed without notice prior to or during the show. Management is not responsible for cancellations due to severe weather or other emergencies.

**CLASS CALLS**: Every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system. However, due to unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate at the prescribed time. **Pay attention to paddock announcements**. Some classes may be small or have no exhibitors, so at times the schedule will move very fast. We will make every attempt to make sure exhibitors are notified of classes in the arena, but exhibitors are responsible for being ready to show when their classes are called to the arena. Once classes are called into the arena, there will be a short gate hold, and then the gate will close. **Once the entry gate has been closed, additional horses will not be permitted to enter and the class will be judged with those present. Entry fees will not be refunded in the case of missed classes. If you need to scratch a class or classes, please notify the paddock master or show secretary before your class is due to enter the ring. Entry fees may be credited to your account if scratches are made in a timely manner before the class runs.** 

BICYCLES, MOPEDS AND SCOOTERS may not be operated around the show office, pavilion, vendor area, stall aisles or paddock area except by disabled persons, DREAM PARK employees or show officials. Roller skates, skateboards, and roller blades are not permitted at all. All minors (under 18 years of age) are not permitted on any type of wheeled vehicle whether motorized or non-motorized, including but not limited to bicycles and scooters. Bicycles are allowed to be ridden in the RV parking area only.

**CAMPER AREAS**: All vehicles in camper areas must be parked in designated spaces. No horse trailer may be parked in camper areas unless horse trailer is used only for living purposes. No horses are permitted in camper areas.

**DISPOSAL OF MEDICAL WASTE**: Sharps containers are provided in Barn A by Stall #1 and Barn B by Stall #1 for disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments.

**DOGS ON COMPETITION GROUNDS**: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained at all times. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted on a horse.

**HOLD HARMLESS**: Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to him/her, his/her horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire, or otherwise. All exhibitors must sign a release form.

**NON-SHOWING HORSES**: If horses are on the show grounds for any reason that are not entered in the show, those horses must meet all health requirements required by the show, including flu/rhino vaccine records, negative Coggins tests, and health papers (if from out of state). All non-showing horses must be listed on an entry form with the show office.

**SAFE SPORT TRAINING:** Due to PFHA's relationship with USEF, we, as an Association, have to abide by certain aspects of our USEF Affiliate Agreement at **ALL** of our PFHA sanctioned events. Even though this show is not a USEF show, **all exhibitors, trainers and owners that are USEF members need to be up to date on their Safe Sport Training BEFORE this competition starts.** Otherwise it will trigger them being put on the USEF Ineligibility list. Exhibitors, owners, or trainers that are not USEF members will not need to complete Safe Sport. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT PFHA RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

### **OPPORTUNITY CLASS RULES**

- 1. Rider cannot have shown previously in any pointed PFHA class.
- 2. Rider does not have to be a member of PFHA to show in the Opportunity Classes.
- 3. The horse must be a PFHA registered Paso Fino and the Rider does not have to own the horse.
- 4. Classes will be judged in accordance with the official PFHA Rule Book for each division with the exception of the riding attire as stated in Number 5.
- 5. Riders are not required to ride in the official PFHA Costume for the division in which they are showing. They are required to wear appropriate casual riding attire. This includes slacks or dark jeans (no shorts), chaps, a casual shirt with sleeves such as a polo shirt or dress shirt. Proper riding boots are required. For participants twelve years of age and under, a riding helmet will be required.
